NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1381 of Title 22, unless there 13 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 14 Notwithstanding any other provision of law concerning 15 postconviction relief, a district attorney in the jurisdiction in 16 which a person was convicted of an offense may file a motion in the 17 district court to vacate or set aside a judgment of conviction at 18 any time if clear and convincing evidence exists establishing that 19 the defendant was convicted of an offense that the defendant did not 20 commit. The district court shall have jurisdiction and authority to 21 consider, hear, and decide the motion. 22 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation 23 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby 24

2	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
