7 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Historical Society;  
8 creating the Oklahoma Museum of Popular Culture  
9 Supplemental Revolving Fund; stating source of funds;  
10 providing for expenditures; requiring certain  
11 determination by the State Treasurer; requiring  
12 transfer of funds if certain determination is not  
13 made by certain date; providing for codification; and  
14 declaring an emergency.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2294.1 of Title 62, unless there  
18 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

19 There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund  
20 for the Oklahoma Historical Society, to be designated the "Oklahoma  
21 Museum of Popular Culture Supplemental Revolving Fund". The fund  
22 shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations,  
23 and shall consist of all monies received by the Oklahoma Historical  
24 Society from appropriations of the Legislature designated for  
deposit in this fund. All monies accruing to the credit of the fund  
are hereby appropriated and shall be budgeted and expended to

1 provide funding for repairs, planning, staging, refurbishments, and  
2 improvements to real and personal property, and for funding for  
3 construction of the Oklahoma Museum of Popular Culture. No  
4 expenditures shall be made from the fund until the State Treasurer  
5 determines that funds provided by local and county governments, the  
6 federal government, or through monetary donations in the amount of  
7 Eighteen Million Dollars (\$18,000,000.00) are made for repairs,  
8 planning, staging, refurbishments, and improvements to real and  
9 personal property, and for funding for construction of the Oklahoma  
10 Museum of Popular Culture; provided, no funds collected or received  
11 prior to the effective date of this act shall be counted towards the  
12 amount. Expenditures from the fund shall be made upon warrants  
13 issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by  
14 law with the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise  
15 Services for approval and payment. On November 15, 2024, if no  
16 determination is made by the Treasurer pursuant to the provisions of  
17 this section authorizing expenditures from this fund, all  
18 unencumbered funds remaining in the Oklahoma Museum of Popular  
19 Culture Supplemental Revolving Fund shall be transferred to the  
20 State Treasurer for deposit in the General Revenue Fund of the State  
21 Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2024.

22 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
23 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby  
24

1 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
2 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
