No person shall be allowed to electioneer 14 within three hundred (300) feet of any ballot box the entrance to a 15 polling place or in-person absentee voting site or a person who is 16 standing in line to vote outside the polling place or in-person 17 absentee voting site while an election is in progress, nor shall 18 any. No person or persons, except election officials, voters 19 registered and voting at the polling place or in-person absentee 20 voting site, a minor child or dependent accompanying such voters and 21 other persons authorized by law_{τ} shall be allowed to remain inside 22 the election enclosure or within fifty (50) feet of any ballot box 23 the entrance to a polling place or in-person absentee voting site 24

while an election is in progress. No printed material other than that provided by the election board shall be publicly placed or exposed within three hundred (300) feet of any ballot box, the entrance to a polling place or in-person absentee voting site while an election is in progress.

6 B. For purposes of this title:

1. "Electioneering" means:

- advocating directly for or against a candidate or 8 a. 9 question that is or will be on the ballot at any 10 election, either verbally or with visual materials, signs or clothing, audio recordings, electronic 11 12 communication, or any other type of communication, or collecting signatures for a petition to place an issue 13 b. or question on a future ballot or soliciting contact 14 information or distributing information for any 15 candidate or issue that might be on a future ballot; 16 17 and
- 18 2. "Election enclosure" means the areas of a polling place
- 19 where voters sign the precinct registry and are issued ballots,

20 where voting booths are located, where a voting device or ballot box

21 is located, and any room, hallway or other space wherein such

22 activities take place.

23 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 26 O.S. 2021, Section 7-108.3, is 24 amended to read as follows:

1 Section 7-108.3. The prohibition against electioneering contained in Section 7--108 7-108 of this title shall apply to any 2 pollster. No pollster shall be permitted inside the election 3 enclosure or within fifty (50) feet of any ballot box the entrance 4 to a polling place or in-person absentee voting site while an 5 election is in progress. A pollster who violates the law prescribed 6 for pollsters shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor. 7 SECTION 3. AMENDATORY 26 O.S. 2021, Section 16-111, is 8 9 amended to read as follows: Section 16-111. Any person who electioneers within three 10 hundred (300) feet of any ballot box the entrance to a polling place 11 12 or in-person absentee voting site or a person who is standing in line to vote outside the polling place or in-person absentee voting 13 site while an election is in progress, and any person except 14 election officials, voters registered and voting at the polling 15 place or in-person absentee voting site, a minor child or dependent 16 accompanying such voters and other persons authorized by law who 17 remains within fifty (50) feet of any ballot box the entrance to a 18 polling place or in-person absentee voting site while an election is 19 in progress shall be deemed quilty of a misdemeanor. 20 SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation 21 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby 22 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and 23 be in full force from and after its passage and approval. 24
