8 An Act relating to Tribal-State agreements; enacting
9 law to offer supplemental compact terms to affirm and
10 extend existing agreements pertaining to motor
vehicle registration and licensing; and providing for
severability.
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13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1221.B of Title 74, unless there
16 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 A. The Legislature finds that:

18 1. Oklahoma has benefited from its implementation of the policy
19 set forth in Section 1221 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes
20 through, among other things, the formation and entry of
21 intergovernmental agreements or compacts with Tribal nations on a
22 variety of subjects;

23 2. As an exercise of executive authority consistent with this
24 codified policy, the Oklahoma Governor formed and entered certain

1 Tribal-State agreements relating to motor vehicle licensing and
2 registration matters, which agreements have benefited all parties by
3 reducing intergovernmental disputes and increasing revenues
4 available for roads, bridges, schools, and other valuable community
5 infrastructure.

6 B. The State of Oklahoma now offers the following supplemental
7 term to any Tribe that was, as of January 1, 2023, a party to a
8 motor vehicle licensing or registration agreement previously
9 executed by an Oklahoma Governor:

10 AFFIRMATION AND EXTENSION OF

11 MOTOR VEHICLE LICENSING/REGISTRATION COMPACT

12 Between the [NAME OF TRIBE]

13 and the STATE OF OKLAHOMA

14 The motor vehicle licensing or registration and license
15 tag agreement formed and entered by the Oklahoma Governor and
16 the [NAME OF TRIBE] is hereby affirmed as a compact between the
17 STATE OF OKLAHOMA and [NAME OF TRIBE] and shall be in effect
18 until December 31, 2024, and any action to unilaterally
19 terminate or to issue written notice of the compact's
20 nonrenewal prior to that date shall be null and void.

21 C. Tribal acceptance of this offer shall be indicated by letter
22 from the Tribal party's governing body or official reciting the
23 terms set forth above and delivered to the Oklahoma Tax Commission.
