The instruction shall 19 20 be designed to enable students to demonstrate competency in reading 21 cursive and legibly writing in cursive by the end of fifth grade. 22 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2024. 23 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation 24 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
