17 An Act relating to daylight saving time; establishing
18 standard time in this state; specifying effect on
19 certain actions; exempting Oklahoma from the federal
20 daylight saving time provision; authorizing future
21 action; providing for codification; and providing an
22 effective date.

23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

24 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 70 of Title 25, unless there is
created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. The standard time in Oklahoma shall be known as Central
Standard Time.

1 B. This section shall not be construed to affect the standard
2 time established by United States law governing the movements of
3 common carriers engaged in interstate commerce or the time for
4 performance of an act by an officer or department of the United
5 States, as established by a statute, lawful order, rule, or
6 regulation of the United States or an agency hereof.

7 C. As authorized by the Uniform Time Act of 1966, as amended,
8 and notwithstanding any other provisions of law to the contrary by
9 the United States government relating to adoption of daylight saving
10 time by all of the states, the State of Oklahoma elects to reject
11 such time and elects to continue in force the terms of subsection A
12 of this section relating to standard time in Oklahoma.

13 D. The rejection of daylight saving time as provided for in
14 this section may be changed by future legislative action.

15 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2024.
