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1 "SECTION 4. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2021, Section 1550.42,
2 is amended to read as follows:

3 Section 1550.42. ~~A.~~ The following entities may create,
4 publish or otherwise manufacture an identification document,
5 identification card, or identification certificate and may possess
6 an engraved plate or other such device for the printing of such
7 identification; provided, the name of the issuing entity shall be
8 clearly printed upon the face of the identification:

9 1. Businesses, companies, corporations, service organizations
10 and federal, state and local governmental agencies for employee
11 identification which is designed to identify the bearer as an
12 employee;

13 2. Businesses, companies, corporations and service
14 organizations for customer identification which is designed to
15 identify the bearer as a customer or member;

16 3. Federal, state and local government agencies for purposes
17 authorized or required by law or any legitimate purpose consistent
18 with the duties of such an agency, including, but not limited to,
19 voter identification cards, driver licenses, nondriver
20 identification cards, passports, birth certificates and social
21 security cards;

22 4. Any public school or state or private educational
23 institution, as defined by Sections 1-106, 21-101 or 3102 of Title

13 last amended by Section 1, Chapter 223, O.S.L. 2023 (26 O.S. Supp.
14 2023, Section 4-109.3), is amended to read as follows:

15 Section 4-109.3. A. When a qualified elector applies for
16 issuance or renewal of an Oklahoma driver license, or issuance of a
17 state identification card issued pursuant to Section 6-105 of Title
18 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes, he or she shall be provided voter
19 registration services as required by the National Voter
20 Registration Act. The person shall be asked whether he or she
21 wishes to register to vote or to change his or her address for
22 voting purposes. A person who declines to register shall confirm
23 such choice in writing or by electronic means. Completed
24 electronic voter registration applications shall be electronically

1 transmitted by the agency accepting the application to the State
2 Election Board or county election board. Completed paper voter
3 registration applications shall be transmitted by the agency
4 accepting the application at the close of business each week to the

6 provided by the State Election Board. If a person registers or
7 declines to register to vote, the office at which the person
8 submits the voter registration application or the fact that the
9 person declined to register shall remain confidential and will be
10 used only for voter registration purposes.

11 B. No voter registration services shall be offered to any
12 person who, at the time of an application for issuance or renewal
13 of an Oklahoma driver license or state identification card,
14 provides documentation that shows that the person is not a citizen
15 of the United States. Any applicant or licensee providing an
16 individual tax identification number to Service Oklahoma or a
17 licensed operator pursuant to Section 6-106 of Title 47 of the
18 Oklahoma Statutes shall not be provided voter registration services
19 as the applicant or licensee is not a qualified elector pursuant to
20 this section.

21 C. A change of address for an Oklahoma driver license or state
22 identification card submitted by a registered voter shall also
23 serve as a change of address for voter registration purposes if the
24 new address is within the same county where the voter is registered

1 to vote. If the new address is outside the county where the voter
2 is currently registered to vote, the voter shall be sent a notice
3 and application with instructions for registering to vote at the
4 new address. A change of address for an Oklahoma driver license or
5 state identification card shall not be used to update a voter
6 registration address if the registrant states in writing or by
7 electronic means that the change of address is not for voter
8 registration purposes.

9 D. Licensed operators shall receive fifty cents (\$0.50) per
10 valid paper voter registration application or application for
11 change in voter registration taken by themselves and employees of
12 the licensed operator's office taken at the licensed operator's
13 office, payable by the State Election Board.

14 E. Service Oklahoma shall notify the Secretary of the State
15 Election Board of licensed operator appointments. Service Oklahoma
16 shall notify the Secretary of the State Election Board of licensed
17 operators qualified to issue driver licenses.

18 F. 1. At least weekly, Service Oklahoma shall electronically
19 transmit to the Secretary of the State Election Board a complete
20 list of identifying information that shall include the name, date
21 of birth, residential address, mailing address, and driver license
22 number of all applicants or licensees who have provided an
23 individual tax identification number pursuant to Section 6-106 of
24 Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

1 2. The Secretary of the State Election Board shall compare the
2 transmitted identifying information provided pursuant to paragraph
3 1 of this subsection with the list of registered voters in each
4 county. The Secretary of the State Election Board shall notify the
5 secretary of any relevant county election board of any matches
6 based on the identifying information provided by Service Oklahoma.

7 3. Upon receipt of notification from the Secretary of the
8 State Election Board pursuant to paragraph 2 of this subsection,
9 the secretary of the county election board shall notify the proper
10 authority pursuant to Section 16-123 of this title to investigate
11 whether a violation related to voting crimes or voter registration
12 has occurred, and any unlawful voter registration shall be
13 automatically canceled.

14 4. The Secretary of the State Election Board shall not retain
15 the information provided pursuant to paragraph 1 of this subsection
16 after the completion of his or her duties pursuant to paragraph 2
17 of this subsection except as may be necessary when assisting with
18 an investigation.

19 G. The Secretary of the State Election Board shall promulgate
20 rules and procedures to implement the requirements of this section.

22 last amended by Section 5, Chapter 47, 1st Extraordinary Session,
23 O.S.L. 2023 (47 O.S. Supp. 2023, Section 6-101), is amended to read

1 Section 6-101. A. No person, except those hereinafter
2 expressly exempted in Sections 6-102 and 6-102.1 of this title,
3 shall operate any motor vehicle upon a highway in this state unless
4 the person has a valid Oklahoma driver license for the class of
5 vehicle being operated under the provisions of this title. No
6 person shall be permitted to possess more than one valid license at
7 any time, except as provided in paragraph 4 of subsection F of this
8 section.

9 B. 1. No person shall operate a Class A commercial motor
10 vehicle unless the person is eighteen (18) years of age or older
11 and holds a valid Class A commercial license, except as provided in
12 paragraph 5 of this subsection and subsection F of this section.
13 Any person holding a valid Class A commercial license shall be
14 permitted to operate motor vehicles in Classes A, B, C and D,
15 except as provided for in paragraph 4 of this subsection.

16 2. No person shall operate a Class B commercial motor vehicle
17 unless the person is eighteen (18) years of age or older and holds
18 a valid Class B commercial license, except as provided in paragraph
19 5 of subsection F of this section. Any person holding a valid
20 Class B commercial license shall be permitted to operate motor
21 vehicles in Classes B, C and D, except as provided for in paragraph
22 4 of this subsection.

23 3. No person shall operate a Class C commercial motor vehicle
24 unless the person is eighteen (18) years of age or older and holds

2 subsection F of this section. Any person holding a valid Class C
3 commercial license shall be permitted to operate motor vehicles in

6 4. No person under twenty-one (21) years of age shall be
7 licensed to operate any motor vehicle which is required to be
8 placarded for hazardous materials pursuant to 49 C.F.R., Part 172,
9 subpart F, except as provided in subsection F of this section;
10 provided, a person eighteen (18) years of age or older may be
11 licensed to operate a farm vehicle which is required to be
12 placarded for hazardous materials pursuant to 49 C.F.R., Part 172,
13 subpart F, except as provided in subsection F of this section.

14 5. A person at least seventeen (17) years of age who
15 successfully completes all examinations required by law may be
16 issued by Service Oklahoma:

17 a. a restricted Class A commercial license which shall
18 grant to the licensee the privilege to operate a
19 Class A or Class B commercial motor vehicle for
20 harvest purposes or a Class D motor vehicle, or

21 b. a restricted Class B commercial license which shall
22 grant to the licensee the privilege to operate a
23 Class B commercial motor vehicle for harvest purposes
24 or a Class D motor vehicle.

1 6. No person shall operate a Class D motor vehicle unless the
2 person is sixteen (16) years of age or older and holds a valid
3 Class D license, except as provided for in Section 6-102 or 6-105
4 of this title. Any person holding a valid Class D license shall be
5 permitted to operate motor vehicles in Class D only.

6 C. Any person issued a driver license pursuant to this section
7 may exercise the privilege thereby granted upon all streets and
8 highways in this state.

9 D. No person shall operate a motorcycle or motor-driven cycle
10 without having a valid Class A, B, C or D license with a motorcycle
11 endorsement. Except as otherwise provided by law, any new
12 applicant for an original driver license shall be required to
13 successfully complete a written examination, vision examination and
14 driving examination for a motorcycle as prescribed by the
15 Department of Public Safety, in conjunction with Service Oklahoma,
16 and a certified state-approved motorcycle basic rider course
17 approved by the Department, in conjunction with Service Oklahoma,
18 if the applicant is seventeen (17) years of age or younger to be
19 eligible for a motorcycle endorsement thereon. The written
20 examination and driving examination for a motorcycle shall be
21 waived by Service Oklahoma upon verification that the person has
22 successfully completed a certified Motorcycle Safety Foundation
23 rider course approved by the Department, in conjunction with
24 Service Oklahoma.

2 lawfully possesses a valid Oklahoma driver license which is
3 eligible for renewal shall be required to successfully complete a
4 written examination, vision examination and driving examination for
5 a motorcycle as prescribed by the Department, in conjunction with
6 Service Oklahoma, and a certified state-approved motorcycle basic
7 rider course approved by the Department, in conjunction with
8 Service Oklahoma, if the person is seventeen (17) years of age or
9 younger to be eligible for a motorcycle endorsement. The written
10 examination and driving examination for a motorcycle shall be
11 waived by Service Oklahoma upon verification that the person has
12 successfully completed a certified Motorcycle Safety Foundation
13 rider course approved by the Department, in conjunction with
14 Service Oklahoma.

15 F. 1. Any person eighteen (18) years of age or older may
16 apply for a restricted Class A, B or C commercial learner permit.
17 Service Oklahoma, after the applicant has passed all parts of the
18 examination for a Class D license and has successfully passed all
19 parts of the examination for a Class A, B or C commercial license
20 other than the driving examination, may issue to the applicant a
21 commercial learner permit which shall entitle the person having
22 immediate lawful possession of the commercial learner permit and a
23 valid Oklahoma driver license or provisional driver license
24 pursuant to Section 6-212 of this title to operate a Class A, B or

1 C commercial motor vehicle upon the public highways solely for the
2 purpose of behind-the-wheel training in accordance with rules
3 promulgated by the Department.

4 2. This commercial learner permit shall be issued for a period
5 as provided in Section 6-115 of this title of one hundred eighty
6 (180) days, which may be renewed one time for an additional one
7 hundred eighty (180) days; provided, such commercial learner permit
8 may be suspended, revoked, canceled, denied or disqualified at the
9 discretion of the Department, with notice to Service Oklahoma, for
10 violation of the restrictions, for failing to give the required or
11 correct information on the application or for violation of any
12 traffic laws of this state pertaining to the operation of a motor
13 vehicle. Except as otherwise provided, the lawful possessor of a
14 commercial learner permit who has been issued a commercial learner
15 permit for a minimum of fourteen (14) days may have the restriction
16 requiring an accompanying driver removed by satisfactorily
17 completing a driver's examination; provided, the removal of a
18 restriction shall not authorize the operation of a Class A, B or C
19 commercial motor vehicle if such operation is otherwise prohibited
20 by law.

21 3. No person shall apply for and Service Oklahoma shall not
22 issue an original Class A, B or C driver license until the person
23 has been issued a commercial learner permit and held the permit for
24 at least fourteen (14) days. Any person who currently holds a

2 commercial driver license shall be required to apply for a
3 commercial learner permit and to hold the permit for at least

5 applicable. Any person who currently holds a Class A, B or C
6 license and who wishes to add an endorsement or remove a
7 restriction for which a skills examination is required shall be
8 required to apply for a commercial learner permit and to hold the
9 permit for at least fourteen (14) days before applying for the
10 endorsement.

11 4. A commercial learner permit shall be issued by Service
12 Oklahoma as a separate and unique document which shall be valid
13 only in conjunction with a valid Oklahoma driver license or
14 provisional driver license pursuant to Section 6-212 of this title,
15 both of which shall be in the possession of the person to whom they
16 have been issued whenever that person is operating a commercial
17 motor vehicle as provided in this subsection.

18 5. After one renewal of a commercial learner permit, as
19 provided in paragraph 2 of this subsection, a commercial permit
20 shall not be renewed again. Any person who has held a commercial
21 learner permit for the initial issuance period and one renewal
22 period shall not be eligible for and Service Oklahoma shall not
23 issue another renewal of the permit; provided, the person may

3 G. 1. For purposes of this title:

4 a. "REAL ID Compliant Driver License" or "Identification
5 Card" means a driver license or identification card
6 issued by this state that has been certified by the
7 United States Department of Homeland Security (USDHS)
8 as compliant with the requirements of the REAL ID Act
9 of 2005, Public Law No. 109-13. A REAL ID Compliant
10 Driver License or Identification Card and the process
11 through which it is issued incorporate a variety of
12 security measures designed to protect the integrity
13 and trustworthiness of the license or card. A REAL
14 ID Compliant Driver License or Identification Card
15 will be clearly marked on the face indicating that it
16 is a compliant document, and

17 b. "REAL ID Noncompliant Driver License" or
18 "Identification Card" means a driver license or
19 identification card issued by this state that has not
20 been certified by the United States Department of
21 Homeland Security (USDHS) as being compliant with the
22 requirements of the REAL ID Act of 2005. A REAL ID
23 Noncompliant Driver License or Identification Card
24 will be clearly marked on the face indicating that it

1 is not compliant with the federal REAL ID Act of 2005
2 and is not acceptable for official federal purposes.
3 The driver license or identification card will have a

6 2. Original Driver License and Identification Card Issuance:

7 a. Application for an original REAL ID Compliant or REAL
8 ID Noncompliant Driver License or Identification Card
9 shall be made to Service Oklahoma.

10 b. Service Oklahoma employees shall perform all document
11 recognition and other requirements needed for
12 approval of an original REAL ID Compliant or REAL ID
13 Noncompliant Driver License or Identification Card
14 application.

15 c. Upon approval of an original REAL ID Compliant or
16 REAL ID Noncompliant Driver License or Identification
17 Card application, the applicant may take the approved
18 application document to a licensed operator to
19 receive a temporary driver license or identification
20 card.

21 d. The licensed operator shall process the approved REAL
22 ID Compliant or REAL ID Noncompliant Driver License
23 or Identification Card application and upon payment
24 shall provide the applicant a temporary driver

2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 6-125 of Title 47, unless there
3 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4 A. Service Oklahoma shall make space available on the
5 credential line of the front of a driver license issued to an
6 applicant who provided an individual tax identification number to
7 prominently print "ITIN Non-citizen", which shall be designed by
8 Service Oklahoma and shall serve as a notation of status as a non-
9 citizen of the United States.

10 B. Service Oklahoma shall include the words "License holder is
11 not a U.S. citizen and is ineligible to vote in any election" on
12 all driver licenses affixed with "ITIN Non-citizen" as required by
13 subsection A of this section.

14 C. An applicant or licensee who provides an individual tax
15 identification number to Service Oklahoma or a licensed operator
16 shall be prohibited from receiving voter registration services as
17 described in subsection A of Section 4-109.3 of Title 26 of the
