8	An Act relating to crimes and punishments; amending 21 O.S. Sections 1704, 1705, and 1706, which relate
9	to penalties for grand larceny and petit larceny; lowering threshold amount that constitutes grand
10	larceny; modifying penalties; and declaring an emergency.

14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
15	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2021, Section 1704, is
16	amended to read as follows:
17	Section 1704. Grand larceny is larceny committed in either of
18	the following cases:
19	1. When the property taken is of a value of <del>One Thousand</del>
20	Dollars (\$1,000.00) Seven Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$750.00) or
21	greater; or
22	2. When such property, although not of a value of <del>One Thousand</del>
23	Dollars (\$1,000.00) Seven Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$750.00) or
24	greater, is taken from the person of another.

1 Larceny in other cases is petit larceny.

2 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2021, Section 1705, is 3 amended to read as follows:

4 Section 1705. A. Grand larceny is a felony punishable as 5 follows:

6 1. If the value of the property is less than One Thousand 7 Dollars (\$1,000.00) Seven Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$750.00), the person shall be punished by imprisonment in the county jail for a 8 9 term not to exceed one (1) year or by incarceration in the county 10 jail for one or more nights or weekends pursuant to Section 991a-2 11 of Title 22 of the Oklahoma Statutes, at the option of the court, or 12 by a fine not to exceed One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), or by both 13 such imprisonment and fine;

14 2. If the property is one or more firearms, the property is 15 taken from the person of another, or the value of the property is 16 One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) Seven Hundred Fifty Dollars 17 (\$750.00) or more but less than Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars 18 (\$2,500.00), the person shall be punished by imprisonment in the 19 custody of the Department of Corrections for a term not to exceed 20 two (2) years or in the county jail for a term not to exceed one (1) 21 year, or by a fine not to exceed One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), 22 or by both such imprisonment and fine;

3. In the event the value of the property is Two Thousand Five
Hundred Dollars (\$2,500.00) or more but less than Fifteen Thousand

Dollars (\$15,000.00), the person shall be punished by imprisonment in the custody of the Department of Corrections for a term not to exceed five (5) years or in the county jail for a term not to exceed one (1) year, or by a fine not to exceed One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), or by both such imprisonment and fine; or

4. If the value of the property is Fifteen Thousand Dollars
(\$15,000.00) or more, the person shall be punished by imprisonment
in the custody of the Department of Corrections for a term not to
exceed eight (8) years, or by a fine not to exceed One Thousand
Dollars (\$1,000.00), or by both such imprisonment and fine.

B. The person shall also be ordered to pay restitution to the victim as provided in Section 991f of Title 22 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

14 SECTION 3. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2021, Section 1706, is 15 amended to read as follows:

Section 1706. <u>A.</u> Petit larceny shall be punishable by a fine of not less than Ten Dollars (\$10.00) or more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), or imprisonment in the county jail not to <u>exceed</u> six (6) months, or by both such fine and imprisonment, at the discretion of the court.

## 21 <u>B. Upon a third or subsequent conviction for petit larceny, the</u> 22 person shall be guilty of a felony.

23 SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
24 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby

1	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
2	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
