NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1692.10 of Title 21, unless 18 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 19 The majority of the voters of a county, voting at an election to 20 be held for such purpose, may approve reducing violations of 21 Sections 1692.2, 1692.3, 1692.4, and 1692.5 of Title 21 of the 22 Oklahoma Statutes to misdemeanor offenses. An election shall be 23 called upon the filing of a petition with the county election board 24 containing not less than five percent (5%) of the number of voters

1	that voted in the most recent gubernatorial election in that county,
2	or by a simple majority vote of the county commissioners in that
3	county.
4	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
