15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
16	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 17 O.S. 2021, Section 347, is
17	amended to read as follows:
18	Section 347. A. No person shall sell or offer for sale motor
19	fuel from a motor fuel dispenser supplied by a storage tank into
20	which motor fuel that contains a mixture of at least one percent
21	(1%) by volume of ethanol or methanol has been delivered within the
22	sixty-day period preceding the date of sale or offer of sale unless
23	the person prominently displays on the dispenser from which the
24	

1	mixture is sold a label that complies with subsection B of this
2	section.
3	B. <u>1.</u> A label as required in subsection A of this section
4	shall:
5	1. Be
6	a. be displayed on each face of the motor fuel dispenser
7	on which the price of the motor fuel mixture sold from
8	the dispenser is displayed <del>;</del>
9	2. State
10	<u>b.</u> <u>state</u> "Contains Ethanol" or "Contains Methanol", as
11	applicable+ <u>,</u>
12	<del>3. Appear</del>
13	<u>c.</u> appear in contrasting colors with block letters at
14	least one-half (1/2) inch high and one-fourth (1/4)
15	inch wide <del>;</del> and
16	4. Be
17	<u>d.</u> <u>be</u> displayed in a clear, conspicuous and prominent
18	manner, visible to customers using either side of the
19	dispenser.
20	2. If the motor fuel contains fifteen percent (15%) ethanol, a
21	pump label as required in subsection A of this section shall meet
22	federal E15 labeling requirements as ruled by the Environmental
23	Protection Agency pursuant to 40 CFR Part 1090.1510 as it is written
24	on February 1, 2023.

1 C. If a motor fuel dispenser is supplied by a storage tank into 2 which motor fuel containing at least ten percent (10%) ethanol by volume or at least five percent (5%) methanol by volume is delivered 3 4 in the sixty-day period preceding the date of the sale or offer of 5 sale, the sign as required in subsection A of this section shall also state the percentage of ethanol or methanol by volume, to the 6 7 nearest whole percent, of the motor fuel having the highest percentage of ethanol or methanol delivered into that storage tank 8 9 during that period.

D. On request by a motor fuel user, a person selling or offering for sale motor fuel from a motor fuel dispenser shall reveal:

The percentage of ethanol contained in the motor fuel being
 sold;

15 2. The percentage of methanol contained in the motor fuel being 16 sold; and

17 3. If the motor fuel contains methanol, the types and
18 percentages of associated cosolvents contained in the motor fuel
19 being sold.

E. The provisions of this section shall not prohibit the posting of any other alcohol or additive information. Other alcohol or additive information and any relevant posting shall be subject to regulation by the Corporation Commission.

1	F. The Corporation Commission shall promulgate rules as
2	necessary to implement the provisions of this section.
3	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
