11 An Act relating to schools; creating the Oklahoma
12 School Safety Training Program Revolving Fund;
13 providing funding sources; declaring purpose of fund;
14 providing for codification; and providing an
15 effective date.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
18 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5-148.4 of Title 70, unless
19 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

20 There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund
21 to be designated the "Oklahoma School Safety Training Program
22 Revolving Fund". The fund shall be a continuing fund, and shall
23 consist of all monies received by the State Department of Education
24 from:

- 1 1. Reimbursements, grants, or other monies received from other
2 state agencies and entities for school security;
- 3 2. Reimbursements, grants, or other monies received from the
4 United States government obligated to school safety training
5 projects;
- 6 3. Gifts, donations, and bequests; and
- 7 4. Monies appropriated or apportioned by the Legislature.

8 All monies accruing to the credit of the Oklahoma School Safety
9 Training Program Revolving Fund are hereby appropriated and may be
10 budgeted and expended by the State Department of Education for the
11 purposes of:

12 Implementation of a crisis management solution. This consists
13 of a hard-wired notification system for identifying the location of
14 a threat notifying staff, law enforcement, and first responders.
15 The notification system shall also notify staff via text, email, and
16 voice alert. The system must also address the time gap issue from
17 the beginning of a violent event until law enforcement support can
18 arrive and end the threat. The crisis management solution shall
19 provide training and implementation of a variety of secured response
20 options, including threshold protection, escape and evade options,
21 and trauma first aid items.

22 Expenditures from the Oklahoma School Safety Training Program
23 Revolving Fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the State
24 Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by law with the

1 Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services for
2 approval and payment.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2024.
