L 6	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
L7	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
L8	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5-148.4 of Title 70, unless
L 9	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
20	There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund
21	to be designated the "Oklahoma School Safety Training Program
22	Revolving Fund". The fund shall be a continuing fund, and shall
23	consist of all monies received by the State Department of Education
24	from:

- 1. Reimbursements, grants, or other monies received from other state agencies and entities for school security;
- 2. Reimbursements, grants, or other monies received from the United States government obligated to school safety training projects;
  - 3. Gifts, donations, and bequests; and

4. Monies appropriated or apportioned by the Legislature.

All monies accruing to the credit of the Oklahoma School Safety
Training Program Revolving Fund are hereby appropriated and may be
budgeted and expended by the State Department of Education for the
purposes of:

Implementation of a crisis management solution. This consists of a hard-wired notification system for identifying the location of a threat notifying staff, law enforcement, and first responders. The notification system shall also notify staff via text, email, and voice alert. The system must also address the time gap issue from the beginning of a violent event until law enforcement support can arrive and end the threat. The crisis management solution shall provide training and implementation of a variety of secured response options, including threshold protection, escape and evade options, and trauma first aid items.

Expenditures from the Oklahoma School Safety Training Program
Revolving Fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the State
Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by law with the

3	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2024.
