A. A private educational institution shall grant 18 only those degrees authorized by the Oklahoma State Regents for 19 Higher Education unless approved otherwise by a national or regional 20 accrediting agency which is recognized by the Secretary of the 21 United States Department of Education as a reliable authority as to 22 the quality of education or training offered by institutions of 23 higher education for the purposes of the Higher Education Act of 24 1965, as amended.

1	B. 1. This section shall not apply to religious degrees which
2	are used solely for religious purposes within a religious
3	organization or any institution of higher education whose primary
4	purpose is to provide religious training or theological education
5	and which is exempt from taxation pursuant to the provisions of
6	Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, 26 U.S.C., Section
7	501(c)(3).
8	2. Each degree title offered pursuant to this subsection shall
9	include a religious modifier. The religious modifier shall be
10	placed on the degree, on the transcript, and wherever the title of
11	the degree appears in official school documents or publications.
12	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2024.
13	SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
14	of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
15	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
16	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
