13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
14	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2021, Section 1704, is
15	amended to read as follows:
16	Section 1704. Grand larceny is larceny committed in either of
17	the following cases:
18	1. When the property taken is of a value of One Thousand
19	Dollars (\$1,000.00) Seven Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$750.00) or
20	greater; or
21	2. When such property, although not of a value of One Thousand
22	Dollars (\$1,000.00) Seven Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$750.00) or
23	greater, is taken from the person of another.
24	Larceny in other cases is petit larceny.

- 1 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2021, Section 1705, is 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 Section 1705. A. Grand larceny is a felony punishable as 4 follows:

- 1. If the value of the property is less than One Thousand

 Dollars (\$1,000.00) Seven Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$750.00), the

 person shall be punished by imprisonment in the county jail for a

 term not to exceed one (1) year or by incarceration in the county

 jail for one or more nights or weekends pursuant to Section 991a-2

 of Title 22 of the Oklahoma Statutes, at the option of the court, or

 by a fine not to exceed One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), or by both

 such imprisonment and fine;
- 2. If the property is one or more firearms, the property is taken from the person of another, or the value of the property is One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) Seven Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$750.00) or more but less than Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$2,500.00), the person shall be punished by imprisonment in the custody of the Department of Corrections for a term not to exceed two (2) years or in the county jail for a term not to exceed one (1) year, or by a fine not to exceed One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), or by both such imprisonment and fine;
- 3. In the event the value of the property is Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$2,500.00) or more but less than Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000.00), the person shall be punished by imprisonment

- 1 in the custody of the Department of Corrections for a term not to
- 2 exceed five (5) years or in the county jail for a term not to exceed
- 3 one (1) year, or by a fine not to exceed One Thousand Dollars
- 4 (\$1,000.00), or by both such imprisonment and fine; or
- 5 4. If the value of the property is Fifteen Thousand Dollars
- 6 (\$15,000.00) or more, the person shall be punished by imprisonment
- 7 | in the custody of the Department of Corrections for a term not to
- 8 exceed eight (8) years, or by a fine not to exceed One Thousand
- 9 Dollars (\$1,000.00), or by both such imprisonment and fine.
- B. The person shall also be ordered to pay restitution to the
- 11 | victim as provided in Section 991f of Title 22 of the Oklahoma
- 12 | Statutes.
- 13 SECTION 3. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2021, Section 1706, is
- 14 amended to read as follows:
- 15 Section 1706. A. Petit larceny shall be punishable by a fine
- 16 of not less than Ten Dollars (\$10.00) or more than Five Hundred
- 17 | Dollars (\$500.00), or imprisonment in the county jail not to exceed
- 18 | six (6) months, or by both such fine and imprisonment, at the
- 19 discretion of the court.
- B. Upon a third or subsequent conviction for petit larceny, the
- 21 person shall be guilty of a felony.
- 22 SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
- of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
