NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.398 of Title 69, unless 14 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 15 The intersection of U.S. Highway 77, also known as the Broadway 16 Extension, and Comfort Drive in Edmond, in Oklahoma County shall be 17 designated as the "SGT Christopher James "CJ" Nelson Memorial 18 Intersection". The Department of Transportation shall cause 19 suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed at the 20 intersection. 21 A new section of law to be codified SECTION 2. NEW LAW 22 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.399 of Title 69, unless 23 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 24

1 The section of U.S. Highway 62 beginning at the intersection of State Highway 6 extending east to the intersection of U.S. Highway 2 283 in Altus, in Jackson County shall be designated as the "Trooper 3 John R. Barter Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation 4 5 shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the highway. 6 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 7 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.400 of Title 69, unless 9 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 10 The section of U.S. Highway 271 beginning at the south edge of Antlers extending south to the intersection of Airport Road in 11 12 Pushmataha County shall be designated as the "Trooper Don Henley Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause 13 suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the 14 highway. 15 A new section of law to be codified SECTION 4. NEW LAW 16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.401 of Title 69, unless 17 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 18 The bridge crossing over E 76th Street on U.S. Highway 169 in 19 Owasso, in Tulsa County shall be designated as the "Bobbi White 20 Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall cause 21 suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the 22

bridge.

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1 SECTION 5. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.402 of Title 69, unless 2 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 3 The section of U.S. Highway 60 just east of the Will Rogers 4 5 Turnpike entrance in Vinita extending easterly to the intersection of State Highway 82 South in Craig County shall be designated as the 6 "Bataan Death March Survivor Elmer "Red" Vanover Memorial Highway". 7 The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent 8 9 markers bearing that name to be placed on the highway. A new section of law to be codified 10 SECTION 6. NEW LAW in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.403 of Title 69, unless 11 12 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: The section of U.S. Highway 60 beginning at the intersection of 13 South Kamo Drive extending northeasterly through Vinita to the west 14 side of the Will Rogers Turnpike entrance in Craig County shall be 15 designated as the "Bronze Star Recipient Marine Sqt. Justin Lee 16 Noyes, KIA Iraq, Memorial Highway". The Department of 17 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that 18 name to be placed on the highway. 19 SECTION 7. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 20 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.404 of Title 69, unless 21 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 22 The section of State Highway 56 beginning at the south edge of 23 Wewoka extending north to the northern limits of Wewoka, in Seminole 24

1 County shall be designated as the "Seminole Warrior John Horse 2 Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the 3 highway. 5 SECTION 8. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.405 of Title 69, unless 6 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 7 The section of State Highway 33 beginning at the intersection of 8 9 State Highway 18 North in Cushing extending west two miles in Payne 10 County shall be designated as the "William A. Ahrberg Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable 11 12 permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the highway. SECTION 9. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.406 of Title 69, unless 14 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 15 The bridge located on U.S. Highway 59 one-half (1/2) mile south 16 of Panama in Leflore County shall be designated as the "Specialist 17 Robert Allan Pierce Memorial Bridge". The Department of 18 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that 19 name to be placed on the bridge. 20 SECTION 10. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 21

in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.407 of Title 69, unless

there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

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1 The bridge crossing over U.S. Highway 75 on U.S. Highway 60 in Bartlesville, Washington County shall be designated as the "Dr. 2 James R. McFarland Memorial Bridge". The Department of 3 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that 4 5 name to be placed on the bridge. SECTION 11. A new section of law to be codified 6 NEW LAW in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.408 of Title 69, unless 7 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 9 The section of State Highway 30 beginning just north of the intersection of E 1060 Road extending north to the intersection of 10 State Highway 47 in Roger Mills County shall be designated as the 11 "MSqt. JW Easterling Memorial Highway". The Department of 12 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that 13 name to be placed on the highway. 14 SECTION 12. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.409 of Title 69, unless 16 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 17 The section of State Highway 48A beginning at the intersection 18 of State Highway 48A South (Wiley Corner) extending east through the 19 community of Fillmore in Johnston County shall be designated as the 20 "CW4 Wendell Carroll LaFevers Memorial Highway". The Department of 21 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that 22 name to be placed on the highway. 23

1 SECTION 13. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.410 of Title 69, unless 2 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 3 The section of State Highway 34 beginning at the north edge of 4 5 the town of Carter extending north to the intersection of State Highway 152 in Beckham County shall be designated as the "Colonel 6 George Henry Normand Memorial Highway". The Department of 7 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that 8 9 name to be placed on the highway. A new section of law to be codified 10 SECTION 14. NEW LAW in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.411 of Title 69, unless 11 12 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: The section of U.S. Highway 60 beginning at the intersection of 13 U.S. Highway 283 extending three (3) miles westerly through the town 14 of Arnett to the intersection of S. Road 1790 in Ellis County shall 15 be designated as the "Marshal George Wilson Reddick Memorial 16 Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable 17 permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the highway. 18 A new section of law to be codified SECTION 15. NEW LAW 19 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.412 of Title 69, unless 20 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 21 The section of State Highway 18 beginning at Black Bear Creek on 22 the north edge of Pawnee extending north to the intersection of the 23 State Highway 15 shall be designated as the "CDR Ernest Evans, First 24

- 4 SECTION 16. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified

- 7 The intersection of State Highway 77H and S.E. 134th Street in
- 8 | Cleveland County shall be designated as the "Emily Gaines Memorial

- 10 | suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the
- 11 highway.
- 12 | SECTION 17. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
- 13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.414 of Title 69, unless
- 14 | there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
- The section of U.S. Highway 277 on the west side of the H.E.
- 16 | Bailey Turnpike and extending west to the intersection of U.S.
- 17 | Highway 62 in Comanche County shall be designated as the "Gold Star
- 18 | Families Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall
- 19 cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on
- 20 | the highway.
- 21 SECTION 18. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
- 22 | in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.415 of Title 69, unless
- 23 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

1 The bridge over Wewoka Creek on U.S. Highway 270 approximately six (6) miles west of the State Highway 56 intersection in Wewoka, 2 Seminole County shall be designated as the "Col. George H. Massad 3 Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall cause 4 5 suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the 6 bridge. SECTION 19. A new section of law to be codified 7 NEW LAW in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.416 of Title 69, unless 9 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 10 The bridge on Interstate 35 crossing over Foothill Road in Carter County shall be designated as the "Shawn Skelly and Michael 11 12 Shane Gilmore Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be 13 placed on the bridge. 14 A new section of law to be codified SECTION 20. 15 NEW LAW in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.417 of Title 69, unless 16 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 17 The section of U.S. Highway 77 beginning at the intersection of 18 South 8th Street extending north to the intersection of U.S. Highway 19 77 and East Post Oak Road in Cleveland County shall be designated as 20 the "PO2 Casey Alan Lewis Memorial Highway". The Department of 21 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that 22 name to be placed on the highway. 23

1 SECTION 21. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.418 of Title 69, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 3 The intersection on U.S. Highway 69 located 350 feet north of 4 5 24th Avenue NE, in Miami, OK in Ottawa County shall be designated as "Chuck Stotts Way". The Department of Transportation shall cause 6 suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed at the 7 intersection. 9 SECTION 22. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.419 of Title 69, unless 10 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 11 12 The interchange of U.S. Highway 412 at the north connection to the Gilcrease Turnpike in Tulsa County shall be designated as the 13 "Guy L. Berry III Memorial Interchange". The Department of 14 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that 15 name to be placed on the highway. 16 SECTION 23. AMENDATORY 69 O.S. 2021, Section 1698.305, 17 is amended to read as follows: 18 Section 1698.305 The bridge located on section of State Highway 19 37 one-half (0.5) mile west of the Stillwater Central Railroad 20 crossing in beginning one (1) mile west of the intersection of State 21 Highway 92 extending east through the town of Tuttle two and one-22 half (2 1/2) miles in Grady County shall be designated as the 23 "Thelma "Chincie" Ross WWII Chickasaw Code Talker Memorial Bridge 24

- 1 | Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable
- 2 | permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the highway.
- 3 SECTION 24. AMENDATORY Section 4, Chapter 356, O.S.L.
- 4 | 2022 (69 O.S. Supp. 2022, Section 1698.367), is amended to read as
- 5 | follows:
- 6 Section 1698.367 The bridge crossing over the Turner Turnpike
- 7 | located on State Highway 18 at the north edge of Chandler in Lincoln
- 8 | County shall be designated as the "Purple Heart Recipient SGT Ronald
- 9 M. Crews Vietnam Veteran Bridge". The Department of Transportation
- 10 | shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be
- 11 placed on the bridge.
- 12 SECTION 25. AMENDATORY Section 28, Chapter 356, O.S.L.
- 13 | 2022 (69 O.S. Supp. 2022, Section 1698.391), is amended to read as
- 14 follows:
- 15 Section 1698.391 The bridge over the Canadian River on
- 16 | Interstate 40 in Canadian County shall be designated as the "Cecil
- 17 A. Davis Sr. Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation
- 18 | shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be
- 19 placed on the bridge.
- 20 SECTION 26. AMENDATORY Section 32, Chapter 356, O.S.L.
- 21 | 2022 (69 O.S. Supp. 2022, Section 1698.395), is amended to read as
- 22 follows:
- Section 1698.395 The section of U.S. Highway 277 beginning at
- 24 | the intersection of Keeney Road near Elgin extending northeasterly

to the H.E. Bailey Turnpike overpass in Comanche County shall be designated as the "Captain Mark A. E. Barker Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the highway. SECTION 27. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
