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10	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
11	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 63 O.S. 2021, Section 1-515, is
12	amended to read as follows:
13	Section 1-515. A. Every physician attending a pregnant woman
14	in Oklahoma during gestation shall, in the case of each woman so
15	attended, take or cause to be taken a sample of blood of such woman
16	at the time of first examination each of the following occurrences,
17	and <u>shall</u> submit such sample to an approved laboratory for a
18	standard serological test for syphilis:
19	1. At the time of the first prenatal visit;
20	2. Between twenty-eight (28) and thirty-two (32) weeks'
21	gestation; and
22	3. At the time of delivery.
23	B. In addition to the occurrences listed in subsection A of
24	this section, the attending physician of a woman presenting with a

1	spontaneous miscarriage or stillbirth shall take or cause to be
2	taken a sample of blood of such woman and shall submit such sample
3	to an approved laboratory for a standard serological test for
4	syphilis.

- C. Every other person permitted by law to attend upon pregnant women in the state but not permitted by law to take blood tests shall cause a sample of the blood of such pregnant woman to be taken by a duly licensed physician, licensed to practice in the State of Oklahoma this state, and submitted to an approved laboratory for a standard serological test for syphilis.
- <u>D.</u> The term "approved laboratory" shall mean a laboratory approved for the purposes of this section by the State Commissioner of Health. A standard serological test for syphilis shall be one recognized as such by the Commissioner. Such laboratory tests shall be made, on request, without charge by the State Department of Health.
- E. Health benefit plans as defined in Section 6060.4 of Title

 36 of the Oklahoma Statutes shall cover the cost of standard

 serological tests for syphilis required under this section.
