12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 157 of Title 4, unless there is  
15 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 A. The Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry  
17 shall maintain on its official website a telephone number connected  
18 to a hotline administered and monitored by the Oklahoma Department  
19 of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry for any damaged state-owned  
20 fencing or state-owned fencing otherwise in disrepair.

21 B. The hotline shall prompt callers to provide the approximate  
22 location of and the date in which the caller first viewed the  
23 damaged or otherwise in disrepair state-owned fencing. The Oklahoma  
24 Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry shall attempt to

1 identify the appropriate state agency or institution responsible for  
2 the fence within a week of receiving the complaint and transmit  
3 electronically and via mail to the state agency or institution a  
4 notification providing the approximate location of and the date in  
5 which the caller first viewed the damage or disrepair.

6 C. The state agency or institution shall act within thirty (30)  
7 days of receiving notification from the Oklahoma Department of  
8 Agriculture, Food, and Forestry to repair the damaged or otherwise  
9 in disrepair state-owned fencing.

10 D. The Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry  
11 is authorized to promulgate rules to effectuate the provisions of  
12 this section.

13 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
