An Act relating to higher education; prohibiting certain test or qualification from being required for admission into or promotion within certain institution of higher education; defining term; providing for termination of employment for certain willful violation; providing certain construction; providing for promulgation of rules; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3251 of Title 70, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

- A. No political test or qualification shall be required as a condition of employment or promotion as a teacher, faculty member, or employee within any institution of higher education within The Oklahoma State System of Higher Education.
  - B. For the purposes of this section, "political test" includes:
- 1. Compelling or soliciting an applicant for employment, a teacher, a faculty member, or an employee to identify commitment to
