16	A. This act shall be known and may be cited as "Alyssa's Law".
17	B. By July 1, 2025, each school district in this state shall
18	implement a mobile panic alert system. The system shall:
19	1. Connect emergency service technologies to ensure real-time
20	coordination among multiple first responder agencies; and
21	2. Integrate with public safety answering point infrastructure
22	to transmit 9-1-1 calls and mobile activations.
23	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2024.
