16	A. After the effective date of this act, all licensing boards
17	of this state providing licensing for professional occupations
18	including, but not limited to, the following shall be required to
19	establish a scope and severity grid to measure the deficiencies in
20	licensed entities to consistently administer citations, penalties,
21	or improvements to establish rules for deficient practices:
22	1. The Oklahoma Accountancy Board;
23	2. The Board of Governors of the Licensed Architects, Landscape

1	3. The State Board of Cosmetology and Barbering;
2	4. The Oklahoma Funeral Board;
3	5. The State Board of Licensure for Professional Engineers and
4	Land Surveyors;
5	6. The State Board of Veterinary Medical Examiners;
6	7. The Oklahoma Real Estate Commission;
7	8. The Real Estate Appraiser Board;
8	9. The Construction Industries Board;
9	10. The Oklahoma Uniform Building Code Commission;
10	11. The Oklahoma Inspector Examiners Committee; and
11	12. The Alarm, Locksmith and Fire Sprinkler Industry Committee.
12	B. Nothing in this section shall be construed to remove,
13	abrogate, reduce, or otherwise affect any power or duty of a
14	licensing board to establish or enforce licensure qualifications,
15	examination requirements, or disciplinary standards or procedures,
16	or to exercise any other power or duty of the licensing board
17	provided by law.
18	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2024.
