 - b. the programs, services, software or processes specified in subsection B of Section 35.6 of this title; and
- 6. "State agency" means any office, elected or appointed officer, bureau, board, commission, counsel, unit, division, body, authority or institution of the executive branch of state government excluding institutions within The Oklahoma State System of Higher Education, the Oklahoma Municipal Power Authority, the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education, the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation, District Attorneys Council, the Office of the Attorney General, the Office of the State Auditor and Inspector, and the telecommunications network known as OneNet.
 - SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.

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
