6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to schools; amending 70 O.S. 2021,
8 Section 6-101.42, which relates to support employee
9 pay; providing for increase in compensation of
10 certain school support employees; prescribing amount
11 of increase; providing increase in compensation as
12 additional to certain other compensation and fringe
13 benefits; providing for pro rata computation;
14 providing an effective date; and declaring an
15 emergency.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 70 O.S. 2021, Section 6-101.42, is
18 amended to read as follows:

19 Section 6-101.42 A. For the 2023-24 school year, each school
20 district shall provide to every support employee a wage increase
21 over the base amount the employee earned during the 2022-23 school
22 year if the support employee is employed by the same school district
23 for the 2023-24 school year in an amount equal to a six percent (6%)
24 increase of the base amount. The dollar amount of salary increase
required by this subsection shall be prorated based upon the number

1 of total hours of work performed by a full-time-equivalent support
2 employee.

3 B. For the 2018-19 school year, each school district shall
4 provide to every support employee a wage increase over the base
5 amount the employee earned during the 2017-18 school year if the
6 support employee is employed by the same school district for the
7 2018-19 school year in the amount of One Thousand Two Hundred Fifty
8 Dollars (\$1,250.00). The dollar amount of salary increase
9 authorized by this subsection shall be prorated based upon the
10 number of total hours of work performed by a full-time-equivalent
11 support employee.

12 ~~B.~~ C. The ~~increase~~ increases prescribed by this section shall
13 be in addition to any other compensation and fringe benefits
14 provided by the district, or mandated by law or collective
15 bargaining agreement, unless the hours or duties of the support
16 employee are reduced proportionately.

17 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2023.

18 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
19 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
20 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
21 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
