This section shall not apply to religious degrees which 24 are used solely for religious purposes within a religious

1 organization or any institution of higher education whose primary 2 purpose is to provide religious training or theological education 3 and which is exempt from taxation pursuant to the provisions of 4 Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, 26 U.S.C., Section 5 501(c)(3). 6 2. Each degree title offered pursuant to this subsection shall 7 include a religious modifier. The religious modifier shall be 8 placed on the degree, on the transcript, and wherever the title of 9 the degree appears in official school documents or publications. 10 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2024. 11 SECTION 3.
