10 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Department of
11 Environmental Quality; making an appropriation;
12 identifying the source; establishing an amount;
13 providing purpose; providing for noncodification;
14 providing an effective date; and declaring an
15 emergency.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
18 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

19 There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Department of
20 Environmental Quality from any monies not otherwise appropriated
21 from the Progressing Rural Economic Prosperity Fund of the State
22 Treasury created in Section 256 of Title 62 of the Oklahoma Statutes
23 Fifty Million Dollars (\$50,000,000.00) or so much thereof as may be
24 necessary to construct needed modifications and upgrades to the

1 levees along the Arkansas River and several feeder waterways located
2 in Northeast Oklahoma.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2024.

4 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
5 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
6 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
7 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
