11	An Act relating to the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry; requiring that
12	portions of funds be used for certain purposes; providing budgeting and expenditure limitations and
13	procedures; providing for lapse of funds under certain conditions; providing an effective date; and
14	declaring an emergency.
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17	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
18	SECTION 1. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma
19	Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry in Enrolled Senate
20	Bill No. 1125 of the 2nd Session of the 59th Oklahoma Legislature,
21	the sum of Six Million Dollars (\$6,000,000.00) shall, under the
22	direction of the Commissioner of Agriculture, be allocated to the
23	Oklahoma State University Robert M. Kerr Food and Agricultural
24	Products Center for various capital and equipment needs.

SECTION 2. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry in Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1125 of the 2nd Session of the 59th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) shall, under the direction of the Commissioner of Agriculture, be allocated to the Oklahoma State University Robert M. Kerr Food and Agricultural Products Center for operational expenses.

8 SECTION 3. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma 9 Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry in Enrolled Senate 10 Bill No. 1125 of the 2nd Session of the 59th Oklahoma Legislature, 11 the sum of Four Million Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$4,200,000.00) 12 shall, under the direction of the Commissioner of Agriculture, be 13 allocated to the extension offices that are affiliated with the 14 Oklahoma State University Agriculture Extension Service.

15 SECTION 4. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma 16 Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry in Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1125 of the 2nd Session of the 59th Oklahoma Legislature, 17 18 the sum of One Million Three Hundred Thousand Dollars 19 (\$1,300,000.00) shall, under the direction of the Commissioner of 20 Agriculture, be allocated to the research centers that are 21 affiliated with Oklahoma State University Agriculture Experiment 22 Stations.

SECTION 5. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma
Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry in Enrolled Senate

Bill No. 1125 of the 2nd Session of the 59th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of Two Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$2,500,000.00) shall, under the direction of the Commissioner of Agriculture, be allocated to cooperative extension and agriculture research programs that are affiliated with Langston University.

6 SECTION 6. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma 7 Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry in Enrolled Senate 8 Bill No. 1125 of the 2nd Session of the 59th Oklahoma Legislature, 9 the sum of Nine Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars 10 (\$9,500,000.00) shall, under the direction of the Commissioner of 11 Agriculture, be allocated in two tranches to renovate a youth camp to be operated for the Oklahoma FFA Association. The first tranche 12 13 shall be for Five Million Dollars (\$5,000,000.00) and shall be used 14 for immediate renovations required to make the camp operational. 15 Upon completion of the aforementioned renovations, the camp operator 16 shall submit a report detailing the expenditures and progress of the 17 renovations to the Governor, Commissioner of Agriculture, the 18 Speaker of the Oklahoma House of Representatives, the President Pro 19 Tempore of the Oklahoma State Senate, the Appropriations and Budget 20 Chair of the Oklahoma House of Representatives, and the 21 Appropriations Chair of the Oklahoma State Senate. Upon receipt of 22 the report, the Commissioner of Agriculture may release the 23 remaining Four Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars 24 (\$4,500,000.00). Upon completion of the expenditure of the

remaining funds, the camp operator shall submit an updated report
detailing the expense and progress of all funds to the same
aforementioned parties.

SECTION 7. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma 4 5 Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry in Enrolled House Bill No. 1004 of the 1st Extraordinary Session of the 59th Oklahoma 6 7 Legislature, the sum of Six Million Eight Hundred Ninety-one Thousand Seventy Dollars (\$6,891,070.00), or so much thereof as may 8 9 be necessary, shall, under the direction of the Commissioner of 10 Agriculture, be allocated to rural fire departments for replacement 11 of equipment and gear, including truck chassis. The Oklahoma 12 Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry may promulgate rules 13 for the distribution and allocation of the funds to rural fire 14 departments.

15 SECTION 8. Appropriations made by this act, not including 16 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for 17 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2025 (hereafter FY-25) or may be 18 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2026 (hereafter FY-26). 19 Funds budgeted for FY-25 may be encumbered only through June 30, 20 2025, and must be expended by November 15, 2025. Any funds 21 remaining after November 15, 2025, and not budgeted for FY-26, shall 22 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal 23 year. Funds budgeted for FY-26 may be encumbered only through June 24 30, 2026. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2026, shall lapse

1	to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.
2	These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years
3	simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-25, and not required to pay
4	obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-26, after
5	the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared
6	and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds
7	from the FY-25 budget work program and after such revision has been
8	approved by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services.
9	SECTION 9. This act shall become effective July 1, 2024.
10	SECTION 10. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
11	of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
12	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
13	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
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
