10 COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

11 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Tourism and
12 Recreation Department; making an appropriation;
13 prescribing expenditures; providing an effective
14 date; and declaring an emergency.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Tourism
17 and Recreation Department from any monies not otherwise appropriated
18 from the Oklahoma Capital Assets Maintenance and Protection Fund of
19 the State Treasury, the sum of Twelve Million Five Hundred Thousand
20 Dollars (\$12,500,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to
21 perform the duties imposed upon the Department by law.

22 SECTION 2. The funds appropriated pursuant to Section 1 of this
23 act shall be expended on properties within the state park system
24 pursuant to a plan submitted by the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation

1 Department not later than May 31, 2024, to the Chair of the
2 Appropriations Committee of the Oklahoma State Senate and the Chair
3 of the Appropriations and Budget Committee of the Oklahoma House of
4 Representatives.

5 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2024.

6 SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
7 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
8 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
9 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
