11	An Act relating to the Oklahoma Historical Society; creating the Oklahoma Museum of Popular Culture
12	Supplemental Revolving Fund; stating source of funds; providing for expenditures; requiring certain
13	determination by the State Treasurer; requiring transfer of funds if certain determination is not
14	made by certain date; providing for codification; and declaring an emergency.

17	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
18	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
19	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2294.1 of Title 62, unless there
20	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
21	There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund
22	for the Oklahoma Historical Society, to be designated the "Oklahoma
23	Museum of Popular Culture Supplemental Revolving Fund". The fund
24	shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations,

1 and shall consist of all monies received by the Oklahoma Historical 2 Society from appropriations of the Legislature designated for deposit in this fund. All monies accruing to the credit of the fund 3 are hereby appropriated and shall be budgeted and expended to 4 5 provide funding for repairs, planning, staging, refurbishments, and improvements to real and personal property, and for funding for 6 construction of the Oklahoma Museum of Popular Culture. No 7 expenditures shall be made from the fund until the State Treasurer 8 9 determines that funds provided by local and county governments, the federal government, or through monetary donations in the amount of 10 Eighteen Million Dollars (\$18,000,000.00) are made for repairs, 11 planning, staging, refurbishments, and improvements to real and 12 13 personal property, and for funding for construction of the Oklahoma Museum of Popular Culture; provided, no funds collected or received 14 prior to the effective date of this act shall be counted towards the 15 amount. Expenditures from the fund shall be made upon warrants 16 17 issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by law with the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise 18 Services for approval and payment. On November 15, 2024, if no 19 determination is made by the Treasurer pursuant to the provisions of 20 this section authorizing expenditures from this fund, all 21 unencumbered funds remaining in the Oklahoma Museum of Popular 22 Culture Supplemental Revolving Fund shall be transferred to the 23

2	Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2024.
3	SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
4	of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
5	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
6	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
