**Research Analysis**

The senate amendments to HB 1045 requires drug testing facilities to report single-use test results that meet the standard to be sent for testing to an employer's review officer by the next working day. The final results, consisting of the single-use tests, confirmatory tests, and quality control data, will then be reviewed and certified.

**Fiscal Analysis**

In its current form, HB1045 proposes to require drug testing facilities to report preliminary positive test results to an employer's review officer as soon as results are available. This measure does not mandate an action to any appropriated state agency. HB1045 is not expected to impact state revenues or state appropriations. The Senate amendment does not change the expected impact of the bill.
