## **Research Analysis**

The Senate amendment to HB 1331 restores the title on the measure.

HB 1331, as amended, authorizes the Commissioner of Labor to establish administrative fines for violating the <u>Boiler and Pressure Vessel Safety Act</u>, which may be in addition to or in lieu of the existing criminal penalties. The fines collected will be deposited to the Department of Labor Administrative Penalty Revolving Fund.

## **Fiscal Analysis**

In its current form, HB1331 allows the Commissioner of Labor to promulgate rules establishing a schedule of administrative penalties and fines for violations of the Boiler and Pressure Vessel Safety Act and/or the Boiler and Pressure Vessel Rules. Funds collected from such violations are to be deposited to the Department of Labor Administrative Penalty Revolving Fund. Officials with the Oklahoma Department of Labor anticipate an associated impact of about \$1000 in the first year of implementation, and \$2000 annually in following years. There are no other considerations to state revenues or state appropriations

The Senate amendment to HB 1331 restores the title.
