## **Research Analysis**

The Senate Amendment to HB 1634 allows a school superintendent to designate a person to transport any found items during a student search to a centralized location or to law enforcement. The designee must have their school ID and a letter from the superintendent confirming their authority to transport such items.

---

HB 1634, as amended, allows schools to remove a student's shoes, hat, and gloves in order to search them for weapons, drugs or alcohol. The measure exempts religious head coverings from being removed. Further, the measure allows a superintendent to designate someone to transport any found items during the student search.
