Research Analysis

The proposed committee substitute for HB1791 gives Oklahoma Health Care Authority liens priority against any third party liability settlement proceeds unless there is also a Medicare lien on file. The measure allows OHCA to further negotiate lien reductions when the injured party, the personal representative or attorney has made a good faith effort to do so. The measure also prohibits providers from requiring subrogation rights against any possible liable third party as a condition of care.

Fiscal Analysis

This measure will allow the Oklahoma Health Care Authority (OHCA) to recuperate taxpayer dollars by allowing OHCA to recoup costs spent on behalf of someone who suffered an injury, disease, or death because of another person's actions. OHCA believes that the changes made in the measure will allow it to recoup another three million dollars (\$3,000,000.00) in taxpayer money.
