Research Analysis

HB 1925 allows a law enforcement agency approved by CLEET to conduct a basic law enforcement academy to require any person or peace officer to execute a promissory note for academy training expenses. The term of the note may not extend longer than 4 years following graduation from the basic academy.

Fiscal Analysis

This measure adds a provision to existing statute that allows law enforcement agencies that were previously approved by the Council on Law Enforcement Education Training (CLEET) to require any person or peace officer to execute a promissory note for academy training expenses payable to the law enforcement agency conducting the training. After consultation with officials from the Department of Public Safety, it has been determined that HB1925 should not have any fiscal impact on state budget or appropriations.
