### **Research Analysis**

HB2003, as introduced, establishes procedures for country treasurers to accept six installments payments for the prepayment of ad valorem taxes for the upcoming fiscal year. The measure provides each treasurer discretion to accept installments payments and requires qualifying taxpayers to provide written notice to the treasurer by January 15 each year of their desired payment method. Accounts with delinquent taxes, accounts with an ongoing valuation protest, taxes paid through an escrow account and public service corporations are not eligible for installment payments.
