Research Analysis

The committee substitute for HB 2251, allows a licensee of the ABLE Commission to serve a mixed beverage or cocktail tasting flights. The flights cannot be more than four separate individual mixed beverages or cocktails that consist of no more than 5 ounces of beer, 1.5 ounces of wine or 0.5 ounces of spirits, to be combined with an unlimited amount of ingredients that are nonalcoholic in nature, and served together at one time.

Fiscal Analysis

As introduced, HB2251 modifies the definition of a tasting flight to include mixed beverages and cocktails. This measure is not expected to impact state revenues or state appropriations. The committee substitute should not change the fiscal impact of the bill.
