Research Analysis

The PCS2 to HB 2851 directs the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation to establish the Alaunna Raffield Fund to assist in training other law enforcement officers with the cost of attending trainings facilitated by the OSBI.

Fiscal Analysis

This measure would provide an avenue to request that Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation (OSBI) conduct certain homicide investigations. Officials from OSBI provided the following analysis:

Caseload per agent could increase anywhere from 23 to 46 additional death investigations per agent per year. Currently, each agent averages 2 of these type of case per year. The average cost per death investigation is around \$256,000.00 at OSBI.

These additional death investigations are not predictable, however based on the estimates provided the additional cost to OSBI could range between \$5,888,000.00 and \$11,776,000.00 per year to OSBI. OSBI would need additional appropriations to handle the increased caseload; therefore, there would be a fiscal impact to the state within that range.
