**Research Analysis**

The committee substitute to House Bill 3016 expands on the definition of "community-based structured crisis center" to include any private agency contracted by the Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services (DMHSAS). The measure also specifies that DMHSAS cannot restrict the number of certified community mental health centers in each service area.

**Fiscal Analysis**

HB 3016 prohibits the Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services (ODMHSAS) from limiting the number of certified community mental health centers in each service area. In addition, this measure expands the definition of *community-based structured crisis centers* to include private agencies contracted by ODMHSAS.

The provisions of this measure are not anticipated to create a negative fiscal impact on the agency or directly impact the state budget.
