The proposed committee substitute for HB3156 prohibits the use of ranked-choice voting, ranked voting, proportional ranked voting, preferential voting or instant runoff voting systems in any state or local election and declares any conflicting local ordinances void. If necessary, the Oklahoma Attorney General or other designated officials can take legal action to enforce this prohibition.

Fiscal Analysis

The proposed committee substitute to HB 3156 prohibits the use of ranked choice voting to conduct any election in the state of Oklahoma and nullifies any existing or future adoption of a voting system in conflict with this measure. As ranked choice voting is not a current in-use voting method, this measure has no direct fiscal or revenue considerations for the state.
