**Fiscal Analysis**

HB 3216 establishes the *Oklahoma Life is a Human Right Act*, in effort to prohibit the prescription of drugs and use of contraceptives with the intent to induce an abortion. This measure directs the physician to preserve the life of the pregnant woman and unborn child when performing a pre-viability separation procedure. A physician who intentionally violates the provisions of this measure will have their license suspended or revoked for a minimum of one (1) year and subject to a civil malpractice lawsuit.

HB 3216 directs the Attorney General to enforce the provisions of this measure on behalf of the State Commissioner of Health. Officials from the Attorney General's Office assured that the obligations set forth are feasible within current budgetary resources. Therefore, this measure is not anticipated to have a negative fiscal impact on the state budget or appropriation.

The second floor amendment does not affect the fiscal impact of this measure.
