Research Analysis

The committee substitute to HB 3642 provides that any person who procures a minor for participation in child pornography or obscene material, or any person who views, accesses, shares, streams, possessed, viewed, accessed, shared, or streamed child pornography or obscene material is subject to prosecution. The measure clarifies the definition of "child pornography" and "obscene material", and "visual depiction".
