House Bill 3793, as introduced, requires the State Department of Health to establish a separate comprehensive system of licensure and certification for facilities for patients who are 17 years of age or under.

**Fiscal Analysis**

HB 3793 requires the State Department of Health (OSDH) to create a separate license and application for nursing homes and residential care homes who provide care for minors, age seventeen (17) and younger.
