**Research Analysis**

The subcommittee recommendation for HB 4016 creates the Oklahoma School Safety Training Revolving Fund to implement a crisis management solution. This solution will consist of a hard-wired notification system that can identify the location of a threat and alert staff, law enforcement, and first responders through text, email, and voice alerts. The system will also address the time gap between the onset of a violent event and law enforcement ending the threat. Additionally, the crisis management solution will provide training and implementation of secured response options.
