FA 2 to HB 4156 provides that if a United State citizen, national, or legal permanent resident alien is wrongly arrested by a law enforcement agency the person is authorized to commence an action for relief in district court in an amount equal to \$10,000 as liquidated damages.

Fiscal Analysis

The FA2 to the measure provides an action for relief to certain alien citizens to be awarded \$10,000 in liquidated damages if they are wrongly arrested by law enforcement. This is not anticipated to have a material impact on state budget or appropriations.
