**Research Analysis**

The proposed committee substitute to HJR1048, is a constitutional amendment mandating that the candidate with the most votes in an election be declared the official winner, and that each voter is entitled to cast a vote for only one candidate for a particular office, and their vote cannot be redistributed to another candidate running for the same office.

The provision would remain in effect unless altered through a constitutional amendment initiated by the voters or a legislative referendum that solely aims to repeal this section without the option to amend.
