**Research Analysis**

The floor substitute to SB 1200 establishes Central Standard Time in Oklahoma as the standard time. Further, the measure exempts the State of Oklahoma from participating in daylight savings time if it is established federally.

**CHANGES IN FLOOR SUB FROM ENGROSSED:**

The floor substitute to SB 1200 establishes Central Standard Time rather than Daylight Saving Time as the year-round standard of time in Oklahoma.
