The engrossed version of SB 1278 allows full-time employees working within The Oklahoma State System of Higher Education to receive 6 weeks of paid maternity leave.

Fiscal Analysis

In consultation with the OSRHE

The most recent FTE count for the higher education system is approximately 28,248. Per the estimate provided by OMES for a similar benefit in SB 16, that population of Executive branch FTE is 34,035 with an estimated fiscal impact of \$3 million.

As such, with all things being equal, it is anticipated that SB 1278 would result in an approximate fiscal impact of \$2,490,000. There are, however, a number of factors that could alter that estimate in a given year.
