Floor amendment 1 to the floor substitute adds a new section the bill to require any financial company that wants to invests a company that is in violation of the Energy Discrimination Act of 2022 to cease accepting state money. The financial company is also required to notify the State Treasurer's office of their intent to invest prior to investing in the noncompliant company.
