**Research Analysis**

SB 1607 prohibits a special election from being called for any vacancy in the county commissioner's office or any other elective county position if the office is set to be listed on the ballot in the same year. Additionally, if the vacancy arises on or after December 1 of an odd-numbered year and the office is slated to appear on the ballot the subsequent year, no special election will be called.

**Fiscal Analysis**

SB 1607 modifies circumstances in which county commissioner or certain elective county office vacancies shall be filled. The measure exclusively addresses the election process for county level candidacies. Therefore, the measure is not state budget related, and is not anticipated to have any fiscal considerations as currently written.
