**Research Analysis**

The engrossed version of SB 27 provides an SAT cut score of 1110, as an alternative to the required ACT cut score of 22, that a homeschooled student, or student graduating from a nonaccredited school must achieve in order to be eligible for an OHLAP scholarship.

Further, the measure allows a student who has completed the core curriculum graduation requirements to be eligible for an OHLAP scholarship to a CareerTech school.
