**Research Analysis**

SB 316 exempts institutions of the Oklahoma State System of Higher Education from the Oklahoma State Government Asset Reduction and Cost Saving Program, which seeks to identify the most underutilized state-owned property within Oklahoma and assess those properties for potential sale. The Oklahoma State System of Higher Education is still required to participate in all data reporting requirements.

**Fiscal Analysis**

SB 316 exempts the institutions of the Oklahoma State System of Higher Education from the Oklahoma State Government Asset Reduction and Cost Savings Program, except for certain data reporting requirements to the Office of Management and Enterprise Services (OMES). This measure has no direct fiscal or revenue considerations for the state.
