**Research Analysis**

The second floor amendment to SB 368 specifies that Section 1 of the measure does not include abortion, as defined in [63 O.S. § 1-730](#), and that abortion does not include U.S. Food and Drug administration-approved hormonal birth control, emergency contraceptives used to prevent pregnancy after sexual intercourse, or long-acting reversible contraceptives.

SB 368, as amended, specifies that Oklahoma laws pertaining to abortion will not be construed to prohibit, restrict, limit, or otherwise affect the provision of contraceptive drugs, surgeries, or other treatments by a duly authorized healthcare provider.

**Fiscal Analysis**

The second floor amendment to SB 368 clarifies that abortion does not include U.S. Food and Drug administration-approved hormonal birth control, emergency contraceptives used to prevent pregnancy after sexual intercourse, or long-acting reversible contraceptives. No fiscal impact.
